

SAHARA Las Vegas 70-Year Anniversary Highlights 1952 – 2022

- 1952 Developer Milton Prell opens the property on October 7; SAHARA welcomes Marilyn Monroe, Charlie McCarthy and Edgar Bergen for the filming of "The Edgar Bergen Show."
- **1953** Sugar Ray Robinson visits SAHARA with his two young children; Marlene Dietrich performs on stage.
- 1954 SAHARA undergoes its first expansion, adding additional hotel rooms to the property.
- 1954 Louis Prima and wife Keely Smith open new act at SAHARA.
- 1955 Grace Kelly visits SAHARA; Elizabeth Taylor and Michael Wilding visit SAHARA.
- **1956** Doris Day visits SAHARA.
- 1958 Eleanor Roosevelt visits Las Vegas and SAHARA to speak on behalf of the United Nations.
- 1960 SAHARA adds new hotel tower to property; Filming begins for "Ocean's Eleven" at SAHARA starring Dean Martin, Sammy Davis Jr. and Frank Sinatra; King of Rock 'n' Roll Elvis Presley arrives at SAHARA; Paul Anka visits SAHARA; George Burns and Ann-Margret perform at SAHARA.
- 1961 Steve Lawrence and Eydie Gorme open at SAHARA.
- 1962 San Francisco Avenue renamed as Sahara Avenue.
- 1962 Donn Beach opens a Don the Beachcomber tiki bar at SAHARA.
- 1963 SAHARA adds second brand-new hotel tower to the property.
- 1964: The Beatles stay at SAHARA during their visit to Las Vegas to perform at the Las Vegas Convention Center.
- **1965** Judy Garland performs on stage at SAHARA; Don Rickles performs on stage at SAHARA.
- 1966 Liberace performs on stage at SAHARA; Liza Minnelli opens at SAHARA.
- 1967 Nancy Wilson opens at SAHARA; Johnny Carson performs at SAHARA.
- 1970 Flip Wilson and Kim Weston perform at SAHARA.
- 1972 Cher visits SAHARA.

- 1974 Miss World auditions take place at SAHARA.
- 1975 Barbi Benton, Hugh Hefner and Marty Robbins visit SAHARA.
- 1977 George Carlin performs on stage at SAHARA.
- 1978 World's first blackjack tournament hosted at SAHARA.
- 1983 George Burns, Tom Smothers, Carol Channing and Robert Goulet visit SAHARA; Sandy and Buddy Hackett visit SAHARA.
- 1985 Leroy Neiman, Phyllis Diller and Tommy Smothers visit SAHARA.
- 1988 SAHARA adds a third hotel tower.
- 1997 Construction of the SAHARA dome begins.
- 2006 SAHARA sign is moved to The Neon Museum in Downtown Las Vegas.
- 2011 The property undergoes renovations to become SLS Las Vegas.
- 2014 SLS Las Vegas opens to the public.
- 2017 Alex Meruelo and his company, Meruelo Gaming, announce the purchase of SLS Las Vegas.
- 2019 The property rebrands as SAHARA Las Vegas.
- 2022 SAHARA Las Vegas celebrates its 70th anniversary and completes a \$200 million renovation incorporating extraordinarily elegant design elements conceived by Nancy Paolino of Las Vegas-based Innovativo Design. The all-new SAHARA includes several eateries, including Noodle Den and Chickie's & Pete's, as well as the AZILO Ultra Pool and Ultra Lounge, a purpose-built theater for the popular MAGIC MIKE LIVE production, a spectacular porte-cochere fronting the Las Vegas Strip and James Beard Award-winning Chef Shawn McClain's Balla Italian Soul.
