Additionally, the company has sign and lighting service franchises throughout North America and operates a sign financing business. In 1920, Thomas Young founded the company in Ogden, Utah, after borrowing \$300 from his father. YESCO began offering wall-painted advertisements, gold-leaf lettering and coffin plates. Shortly after the advent of the neon tube, the company grew rapidly and was soon manufacturing, installing and servicing signs throughout the Intermountain West. Headquartered in Salt Lake City, YESCO operates across the United States and Canada. YESCO creates award- winning signs and displays from dazzling spectaculars on the Las Vegas Strip, to simple but elegant signage for companies of all types. Today, the third and fourth generations of the founder's family continue the work of leading the company forward, maintaining the legacy of light that began over 100 years ago.
